IN THIS WORKSHOP, we will explore sacred stories told in the *Caṇḍī Pāṭhaḥ*, a mysterious and powerful scripture chanted during Navaratra, the nine-day worship of the Goddess. *Caṇḍī Pāṭhaḥ* is one of the most important texts of the Goddess tradition. We will interpret the deeper meanings of the stories told in this text in the light of the teachings of Kashmir Shaivism, an ancient nondual philosophical tradition. The workshop will include exposition, question-answers, and guided meditations.
